
Inspection Report of Sakshi Malik Govt. College for Girls, Mokhra, Distt. Rohtak


Inspection committee comprising of Prof. Sanjay Dahiya, Deptt. of Physics, Dr. Hari Mohan, Deptt. of Medical Bio Technology, Dr. Babita Khosla, Dept. of EVS and Dr. Anju Rani, Deptt. of Mathematics visited Sakshi Malik Govt. College for Girls, Mokhra, Distt. Rohtak on 04-03-2021 regarding periodical inspection of the college. The committee interacted with the principal, teaching and non-teaching staff members available in the college at the time of inspection and inspected the physical infrastructure as well as other facilities available with the college. All

The observations of the committee are as under:


1. The college is running only B.A. course with two units of 160seats (80 seats in each unit).
2. The College has admitted students to this course and the present status (2020-21) of admissions is as follows:
B.A-1st - 67, B.A-2nd - 78 and B.A- 3rd - 45.
3. The college has Principal's room, Staff room, Administrative office and visitor's room. The college also has sufficient number of class rooms with adequate space as per the sanction strength, Multipurpose Hall, Seminar room, smart classroom, separate common rooms for boys and girls and have sufficient parking space. College has facility of safe drinking water, canteen and has fire safety equipment installed in college premises.
4. The college has regular Principal. The Principal provided the list of faculty members (attached). To run the above course the college has twelve (12) regular faculty members, five (05) regular non-teaching staff members, two (02) non-teaching staff members on contractual basis and five (05) workers on outsourcing policy.
5. The college has good Laboratories for the subject of Geography. However there is requirement of more instruments/apparatus in Geography laboratories
6. The college has sufficient number of computers with internet facility.
7. The College has a library cum reading room with 2054 books relevant to the course, internet, photocopy facility and only two (02) news papers. However college library should have more newspapers, magazines and Journals

Based on the above observations, the committee recommends the grant of continuation of affiliation to existing B.A course with intake of two units of 160seats (80 seats in each unit).
